

Call for papers 6th FIRN PhD Symposium to be held during FIRN Annual Conference 21-24 November, 2023 Hobart, Tasmania

FIRN cordially invites PhD students from member institutions to submit a paper to the 6th FIRN PhD Symposium which is being held during the FIRN Annual Conference, 21-24 November 2022 at the University of Tasmania Hobart Campus, Tasmania.

Presenters at the symposium will receive high-quality feedback in a supportive atmosphere from fellow students and senior academics.

Paper submission conditions:

- Only one paper per presenting author may be submitted.
- Papers may not be already accepted for publication.
- Papers in all areas of finance are welcome
- Paper author(s) must allow a copy of the paper to be made available to other conference participants.

Submission Format: Please submit (1) a blind copy of the manuscript without author information, and (2) a separate non-blind file with the cover page containing the paper title, abstract and authors' contact information and a copy of the manuscript. PDF or MS-Word version documents can be submitted to the submission website.

Submission Deadline: 1 May 2023

Evaluation: All papers will be double-blind refereed. Acceptance decisions will preference final year students and a diversity of representation from FIRN member institutions.

Costs and Financial Support: FIRN will cover the conference registration fee and shared room accommodation expense at the Hamilton Island resort for students who are accepted into the symposium.
