2023 Melbourne Asset Pricing Meeting

DESCRIPTION:

You are invited to submit your paper to the 10th annual Melbourne Asset Pricing Meeting hosted by The University of Melbourne and FIRN, Australia's Global Finance Research Network. The meeting is a one-day conference to be held in person on Monday, 23 October 2023 at The University of Melbourne in Melbourne, Australia and will include paper presentations and discussions, with prizes for the best paper and best discussant.

We invite researchers to submit unpublished empirical or theoretical papers on all topics in asset pricing and investments. Possible topics include but are not limited to: theoretical and empirical models of asset prices and returns, return predictability, empirical methodology, macro-finance, the study of financial institutions as related to asset prices, information and liquidity in asset markets, behavioural investment studies, asset market structure and microstructure, risk analysis, hedge funds, mutual funds, pension funds, ESG, the impact of COVID-19, and alternative investments.

AWARDS:

There will be a prize of A\$1,000 each awarded to the best paper and to the best discussion at the meeting.

PAPER SUBMISSIONS:

Interested authors are invited to submit their papers to ap-meeting@unimelb.edu.au by **31 May 2023**. There is no submission fee. Please note, that the Melbourne Asset Pricing Meeting will be held in person at the University of Melbourne in Melbourne, Australia. Acceptance emails will be sent by 31 July 2023, and you will be asked to confirm your in-person attendance before your paper is included in the conference program.

PAPER SUBMISSION CONDITIONS:

- Only 1 paper per presenting author may be submitted.
- Papers may not be already accepted for publication.
- Paper author(s) must allow a copy of the paper to be made available to other conference participants.
- Only completed papers should be submitted.

SUBMISSION FORMAT:

Please submit (1) a blind copy of the manuscript without author information, and (2) a non-blind copy of the manuscript with a title page containing all author information. Only PDF documents can be submitted.
