The one-week intensive writing course is designed to help early-career researchers improve their academic writing.

#### About the speaker

Professor Eliezer Fich is the Trustee Professor of Finance at Drexel University's LeBow College of Business. He has a PhD in Business Administration from the NYU Stern School of Business and undergraduate and graduate degrees from Columbia University. He has published numerous peer-reviewed articles in the most prestigious Finance and Accounting academic journals. Professor Fich's research has been quoted by leading business periodicals such as The Wall Street Journal, The Financial Times, and The Economist. His research focuses on the firm value implications of Corporate Governance, Mergers and Acquisitions, and Securities Laws.

### About the writing course

This course is developed to educate early-career researchers conducting *empirical research* (in finance, accounting, economics or related disciplines) about aspects of scientific writing that are not normally part of doctoral curriculum but are necessary to succeed as an academic. The main focus will be on creating and presenting an academic paper. The course is specifically designed with the goal of generating a manuscript based on a research proposal.
